WHAT IS PPR?

- One of the most dreaded disease affecting goats, sheep, and some wild relatives of domesticated small ruminants, as well as camels
- Highly contagious transboundary viral disease with Mortality and Morbidity which can exceed 90%.
- Most African countries are infected, with the exception of some countries in the southern part of the continent.
- The disease has serious impact of sheep & Goat production in Africa

Estimated Small ruminant population by region

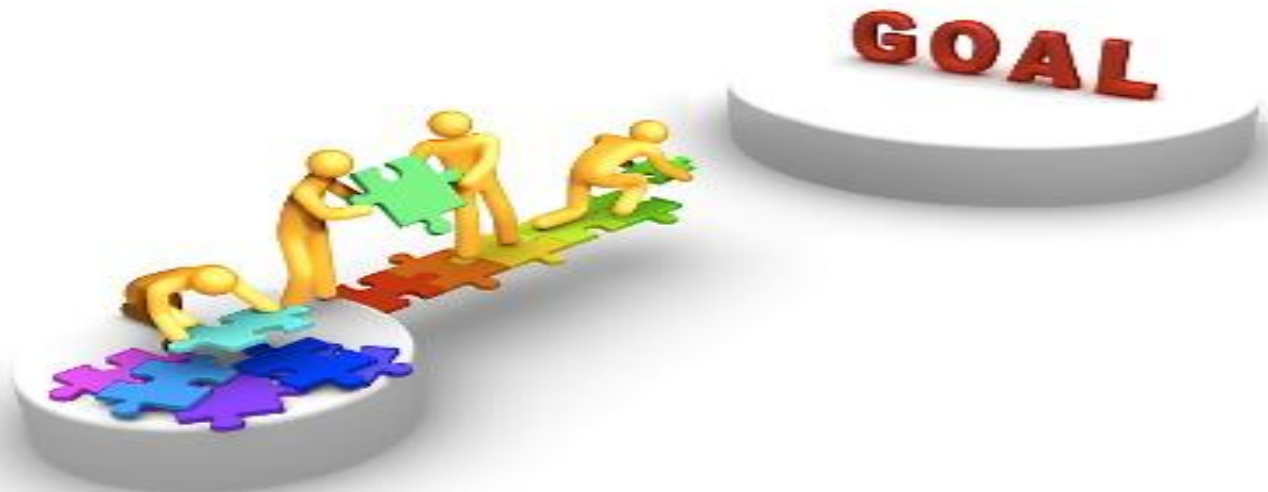

To eradicate PPR in Africa by 2030



PROJECT SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- To eradicate PPR in endemic countries and maintain the absence of PPR in non-infected countries
- To reinforce the Critical Competencies of Veterinary Services to enhance the control and eradication of PPR and other priority sheep and goats diseases

PROJECT SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES...

- To promote investments in livestock - based business models along the key value chains to enhance sustainable production, productivity and access to markets
- To strengthen coordination and partnerships for the eradication of PPR and control of other priority small ruminant diseases

MAIN ACTIVITIES BY RESULT AREAS





RESULT 1: Enabling environment , animal health systems for PPR eradication and the control of other priority small ruminant diseases enhanced

- 1. Review and validate the PPR eradication and investment plans by stakeholders.**
- 2. Support stakeholder analysis, awareness, organisation and engagement.**
- 3. Improve legal frameworks for the eradication of PPR and control of other priority small ruminant diseases.**
- 4. Support the Strengthening of Veterinary Services in MSs based on the outcome of OIE PVS evaluation and PPR PMAT.**



RESULT 2: Measures towards the eradication of PPR and the control of other priority small ruminant diseases improved

- 1. Conduct epidemiological and socio-economic assessments.**
- 2. Support strengthening of national and regional surveillance systems**
- 3. Support strengthening of capacities of diagnostic laboratories**
- 4. Improve the understanding the role of wildlife in the epidemiology of PPR.**



RESULT 2: Measures towards the eradication of PPR and the control of other priority small ruminant diseases improved

- 5. Support access to quality vaccines and vaccine delivery through public private partnerships**
- 6. Support the strengthening of Regional and National Animal Health Networks.**
- 7. Support MSs to demonstrate freedom from PPR following OIE standards**
- 8. Support the control of other priority small ruminant diseases (in support of PPR eradication).**



RESULT 3: Strategic partnerships and business models for enhanced performance of small ruminants value chains

- 1. Support RECs and MS to conduct inventory and analysis of small ruminant value chains.**
- 2. Promote intra and inter country harmonization through MoUs / Protocols for animal health and productivity**
- 3. Support intra and inter country harmonization through MoUs / Protocols for animal identification and traceability for market access and sanitary safety of trade.**



RESULT 3: Strategic partnerships and business models for enhanced performance of small ruminants value chains (cnt...

- 4. Support resilience building and creation of alternative sources of employment and income for farmers, particularly women, youth and other vulnerable groups.**
- 5. Support the enhancement of capacities for sustainable natural resources management and pastoralism**
- 6. Support building capacities for sustainable small ruminants' enterprise**



RESULT 4: Coordination, management and strategic partnerships at all levels strengthened

- **Review and identify an appropriate project management system based on lessons learnt from past projects / programs. This will lead to:**
 - 1. Enhance national level coordination and management.**
 - 2. Promote operational coordination through RECs.**
 - 3. Improve policy and strategic coordination at continental level.**
 - 4. Strengthen coordination with Global technical partners (FAO,OIE, IAEA etc)**
 - 5. Promote a vibrant and relevant Public Private Partnerships (PPPs)**

Result 2: Measures towards the eradication of PPR and the control of other priority small ruminant diseases improved	341,900,000 (65%)
Result 3: Strategic partnerships and business models for enhanced performance of small ruminants value chains	52 600 (10%)
Result 4 & 5: Coordination, management and strategic partnerships at all levels strengthened	42,080,000 (8%)
Sub-total	462,880,000 (88%)

BUDGET MOBILISATION PLAN
